Re: Proprietary Fonts within ProtoShare Product

Dear Mr. Mottaz:

This office represents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as well as several other prominent font software companies. Our clients are the owners of font software programs which are licensed for distribution to end-users and into numerous software products. It has come to our attention that the ProtoShare product offered by your company utilizes our client's software programs without a license.

A review of the ProtoShare product gives my client the good faith belief that the following font software programs are resident in the product: Andalé Mono, Arial, Arial Black, Book Antiqua, Comic Sans MS, Courier New, Georgia, Helvetica, Impact, Symbol, Tahoma, Times New Roman, Trebuchet MS, Verdana, Webdings and Wingdings (see attached screen captures from the ProtoShare product). My clients own copyrights in the software for all of the foregoing programs. Additionally, my clients have federal trademark registrations for the name 'Andalé,' 'Arial,' 'Book Antiqua,' 'Comic Sans,' 'Georgia,' 'Helvetica,' 'Impact' (pending), 'Tahoma,' 'Times New Roman,' 'Trebuchet,' 'Verdana,' 'Webdings,' and 'Wingdings' (see attached) as applied to font software programs. [REDACTED] of the Creative Professionals division of [REDACTED], attempted to contact Protoshare regarding this issue without success.

The continued use and distribution of our client's font software programs constitutes copyright and trademark infringement. **It is imperative ProtoShare immediately cease and desist all unauthorized use and distribution of our client's proprietary software.** After we

have received confirmation that all such use and distribution has ceased, we will then be prepared to discuss the damages which my clients have sustained and whether ProtoShare may legitimize its use of my clients' software.

Unless we hear from you by the close of business, **June 12, 2009**, we will assume your company intends to keep infringing our clients' rights and will act accordingly and without further notice. I hereby state that I am authorized to act for the above entities and that the information in this letter is accurate as to the best of my knowledge and belief.
